



THE EAST DORSET AND WEST HANTS RAILWAY

This HO/OO scale preserved line lies on the Dorset/Hampshire border between Bournemouth, Ringwood and Wimborne. It has one station at the village of Beechings Axe.

The line is a loop. The station is preserved in the style of the Southern Railway circa 1940. The line was first bought by the ED&WHR in 1999 and is continually being extended.

The line is very busy. Its freight trains serve the nearby porridge mines. The ED&WHR also runs regular passenger services from Beechings Axe where there is an interchange with Railtrack. Regular and excursion services are run in conjunction with Railtrack and Sodor Railways.



Long distance travellers can connect from Beechings Axe with Virgin Trains 125 services, and with the Eurostar for Paris. Steam enthusiasts can travel on 'The Flying Scotsman' and 'The Princess Victoria' in the luxury of yesteryear.
