Andy is ordained as a vicar by the Church of England (based in Cumbria) and Harry is... well, possibly the nicest bloke in the universe. As delegated keeper of the flame Gary worked in 2017 on 're-visioning' unissued archive material using the 'latest technology' (*sic* – see below). Note the '77', '87', '07', '17 synchronicity, Man! This work is ongoing to prepare future charity

releases that do justice to the group's legacy. Andy too has agreed to contribute, and the work is fully sanctioned by all four – who even now have a ['Facebook'](#) page.
