



REFORMATION

In 2007, after a decade of inactivity (see 'Gary's Previous Life (to 1996)'), RADIO **BOSCOMBE re-grouped (line-up #10 for** those of you out there counting!) For lo, it came to pass e-mails concerning royalties bantered and flashed back and forth in the darkness, and JONATHAN THE JESTER (aka Jonathan Russell) suggested how



much he missed working with the others. GARY MITCHELL suggested in that case they try it again, ANNE LYDON said, 'yeah, why not'. MORGAN McGINNIS has kinda declined - though she might be in again for the odd recording session in between scribing her latest radio and stage plays. Unfortunately, due to personal commitments, ANNE had

to drop out of the reunion, and 'retired' until 2011,



when she made a solo comeback.

Undaunted, GARY and JON forged ahead - writing and recording new material for 'Hope FM's' 'Weekend Breakfast Show'. They also appeared on 'Hope's' Wednesday night arts show 'Livewire Live' and on 'Forest FM's' drivetime 'Laura Jerome



Show' - and in 2008 released the critically acclaimed and post-code

best-selling CD, 'Can't Get A Girl !'

After that they 'got a girl' (ha ha!) by recruiting JON'S 'apprentice' PIXIE JESTER (aka Pauline Gillespie) to complete line-up #11 - and continue recording for more broadcasts and a new album. GARY, meanwhile, had been working with young writer and performer GEORGE ATTWILL a lot over the previous year - and because he's cheap it made sense to recruit him too - so were now back to the classic 'three-boys-and-a-girl' line-up so



beloved by Seventies casting directors (#12 for those of you out there counting).

STEP TWO



As a quartet JON, GARY, GEORGE and PIXIE recorded a new CD 'How Can You Hate Them ??' (2008). This 17th set featured seventy minutes of all new material - including live takes from radio broadcasts. The plan was next to move forward and work on improving the quality of writing and performances and up the game - also to finally GO LIVE in 2009! We dun it too! As a consequence of all this they were regularly broadcast by DJ Paul Edwards on 'Punkyradio', at 'Punkyradio

<u>Podcasts'</u>, and on Jon's own show on <u>'Forest FM'</u>. They also appear monthly on 'Hope FM 's' Wednesday night arts show <u>'Livewire Live'</u>. We've also been on 'The APS Variety Hour', broadcast via 'Nerve Radio' (<u>http://www.nervemedia.org.uk/listentonerve/</u>).

REORGANISATION



July to August 2009 - and in order to fulfil their plans for global domination Radio Boscombe reorganised.



In July Heidi Attwill (*right*) was drafted to help out as support and crew, PIXIE taking a step back due to work commitments.

Broadcaster and musician LAURA JEROME (*left*) joined to make line-up #13, and we went into rehearsal and planning, aiming to be regularly gigging by Sept 2009 - and at the Edinburgh Fringe by 2011. Too ambitious? Maybe... Unfortunately, in August 2009, due to pressure of work, JONATHAN was obliged to concentrate on his solo career,

so GARY, GEORGE and Laura became lineup #14.



We set to work, writing, recording and touring. Well, going to Bournemouth and doing bits there...

In 2010 we released our first studio CD in two years, 'The Voices In Our Heads' (see ' Shop ') and launched our 'supergroup' The New Forest Pit Ponies.





In July 2011 we released a new 'studio' CD 'Rolling In The Deep' (see 'Shop'). Actually, this is a bit of a misnomer as some of it was recorded live, and the garage doesn't really count as a proper studio, does it?









In October 2012 we released another album, '*Intermission*', which is, like, our most recent before a break - hence the title (see '*Shop*').

HIATUS (FEB TO SEPT. 2013)

Ok, why the break? Well, were all too busy doing other career things - Gary in Bournemouth doing writing and solo stuff, George in the USA and all over doing acting and Lozza in Spain DJing, so it made sense to do a Ross'N'Rachel. We (individually and sometimes in twos) continued to fulfill our radio commitments.

REGROUPING (SEPT. 2013+)

We regrouped to do some more material as we're all currently in the UK. Sadly, due to his extensive acting commitments, being famous, and being banged-up on chokey Stateside GEORGE has decided to take a sabbatical from Feb. 2014 until he's (in)'famous'.

With that in mind we recruited local actor and musician and broadcaster PAUL JEROME, who's known and worked with LAURA for a number of years on account of being her dad [©] He's done voice-overs for THE NEW FOREST PIT PONIES as well. Other friends and ex-members like JONATHAN THE JESTER were back to help out too on our album '*The One Where George Is On A Break...*' out May 2014 (see '*Shop*').

So, buy our CDs and listen in - or we'll all have to get proper jobs ⁽²⁾ We also have some 'freebie' badges and keyrings - just mail us and we'll get one to you.

2015 THIRTIETH ANNIVERSAY

To celebrate we invited everyone from previous line'ups to join in, and ANNE LYDON and JONATHAN THE JESTER duly returned to record; NICK CAULKIN to do some calligraphy.

The result is our latest double CD '30' – one disc '*Raiders Of The Last Archives*' being the best of the previously unreleased, the other '*Back To The Future*' being all new material.

It's also (deliberately) our 30th album – and has sold in staggering numbers. Big or small – you tell us!






2016-17 'QUIET TIME'

We got back together again in the Autumn of 2017 with RICHARD 'Skinny Richard' BREWER (former <u>Project X</u> with Gary) joining the 'team'. We say, 'team', more like hungover blokes down the pub on a wet Sunday league morning than FC Barcelona, but never mind...


Despite other commitments, the group began recording and will (hopefully) be performing live and on the radio – and possibly cat-juggling and worrying otters.

The first results of this latest *renaissance* is our latest CD '*Fascism By the Back Door*' – rather conveniently released ready for Xmas 2018 sales!

2019 'NOT BACK AGAIN'

First, RICHARD BREWER left to pursue his literary Career – the group's Brexit themed CD is still in the pipeline as they wrote lots of new material and planned to invade Poland and start WWH also have friends collaborate with them, for mutual benefit.





Sadly, due to pressures elsewhere, none of this came to pass. As of the 2nd September RADIO BOSCOMBE, therefore, reluctantly closed down for the foreseeable future.

In 2021 they contributed to the various artists concept album, '*My Little Brexit*', about the inevitable economic collapse, civil unrest and bitter recriminations as friends and family are torn apart in a way not seen since the civil wars of the 17th century*.

During lockdown qualified (and out-of-contract) librarian GARY cleaned and tidied the archives, and has (virtually) completed remastering and re-releasing the groups early 'cassette' albums as CD available via this website (all except the '*Bootleg*' series, which are for internal use only).
